³ Buckle shall be plain brass with no rank, rating, ship, or service insignia.

⁴ Boxer style with button fly, no elastic waist bands, or “jockey shorts”

⁵ One cap may be died dark blue or gray at the discretion of individual Division heads.

⁶ Dungarees shall be of a period styles (number of rear pockets and the cut of the front pockets varied between the 4-5 “authorized patterns), and cut (wider thigh with a bell bottom vs. current narrow thigh with bell bottom), with button fly. Modern Seafarers are not acceptable.

⁷ Undershirts must be of a shallow-rounded, thin trimmed collar style. Modern V-neck and Crew-neck t-shirts are not acceptable.

⁸ Seabag may have either sewn, brass, or steel grommets. Drawstring shall be white cotton.

⁹ All enlisted “Blues” for shipboard us shall be made of blue melton wool and of “regulation design”. Tailor-mades, liberty, and/or gabardine dress uniforms were part of the WWII Navy, but were frowned upon in the “Battleship Navy.” Now, as then, sailors may or may not be allowed on liberty in such uniforms at the discretion of the Officer of the Deck.

¹⁰ If original whites are used, the must be free of stains, rust, and yellowing.

¹¹ Pea Coats must be of the WWII, 5-button style vs. modern 4-button jackets

¹² May be plain white smooth-weave wool, or original WWII issue with blue bars and US NAVY on ends. Modern surplus white blankets with a US, USN or US NAVY stencil in the center is not acceptable.
